UH Transfer Rules

- Courses taken at AC must be completed with a C- or better.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer credits can be used towards a UH bachelor's degree.
- A maximum of 2 credit hours in physical activity courses can transfer.

Major Requirements

- B.S. Math: complete 12 hours of approved mathematics courses.
 Approved mathematics courses include: BUSI 2305, COSC 1436, all college-level MATH subject courses, or PSYC 2317. At least 6 hours must be MATH subject courses.
- **B.S. Natural Science**: complete 8 hours of science courses. Students majoring in Exercise & Fitness Studies will fulfill this requirement through major coursework.
- Minor: complete a minor or approved substitute. No more than 6 hours of major coursework can be used towards the minor.
- Complete PHED 1301 and KIN 2304 with a grade of C- or better.
