COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN HOTEL AND RESTAURANT MANAGEMENT

Completion of the bachelor's degree requires a minimum of 120 credit hours of course work and a minimum of 1000 clock hours of work experience in the hospitality industry (GHL 2160=400 work hours, GHL 4360=300 work hours & 300 internship hours). Students must satisfy at least 36 advanced credit hours and at least 24 of the last 30 semester credit hours in residence. Students wishing to declare a major in Hotel & Restaurant Management must earn a minimum cumulative UH GPA of 2.75, submit a completed UH General Petition form declaring this major to the HRM Office of Academic Services, and sign an official major degree plan.
