Join honors students from universities across the United States in exploring the complex issues around food justice. Collaborating with experts from a variety of fields, you will engage with real social needs and develop your capacity for civic engagement, innovation, and leadership.

In addition to the weekly colloquium, students will participate in an opening one-day workshop and participate during the spring or summer of 2024 in one of three (depending on their interests and needs) signature experiences:

- a Design Challenge (semester-long course, in-person);
- a Hackathon (2-day, in person or online); or
- a Field Course (1 week, in-person),

followed by a culminating conference.

You must be accepted into the national Grand Challenge Scholars Academy's Justice Challenge to be eligible to register for the course. The application deadline has been extended until all spots are filled. See the remainder of this document for additional details and the link to apply.
