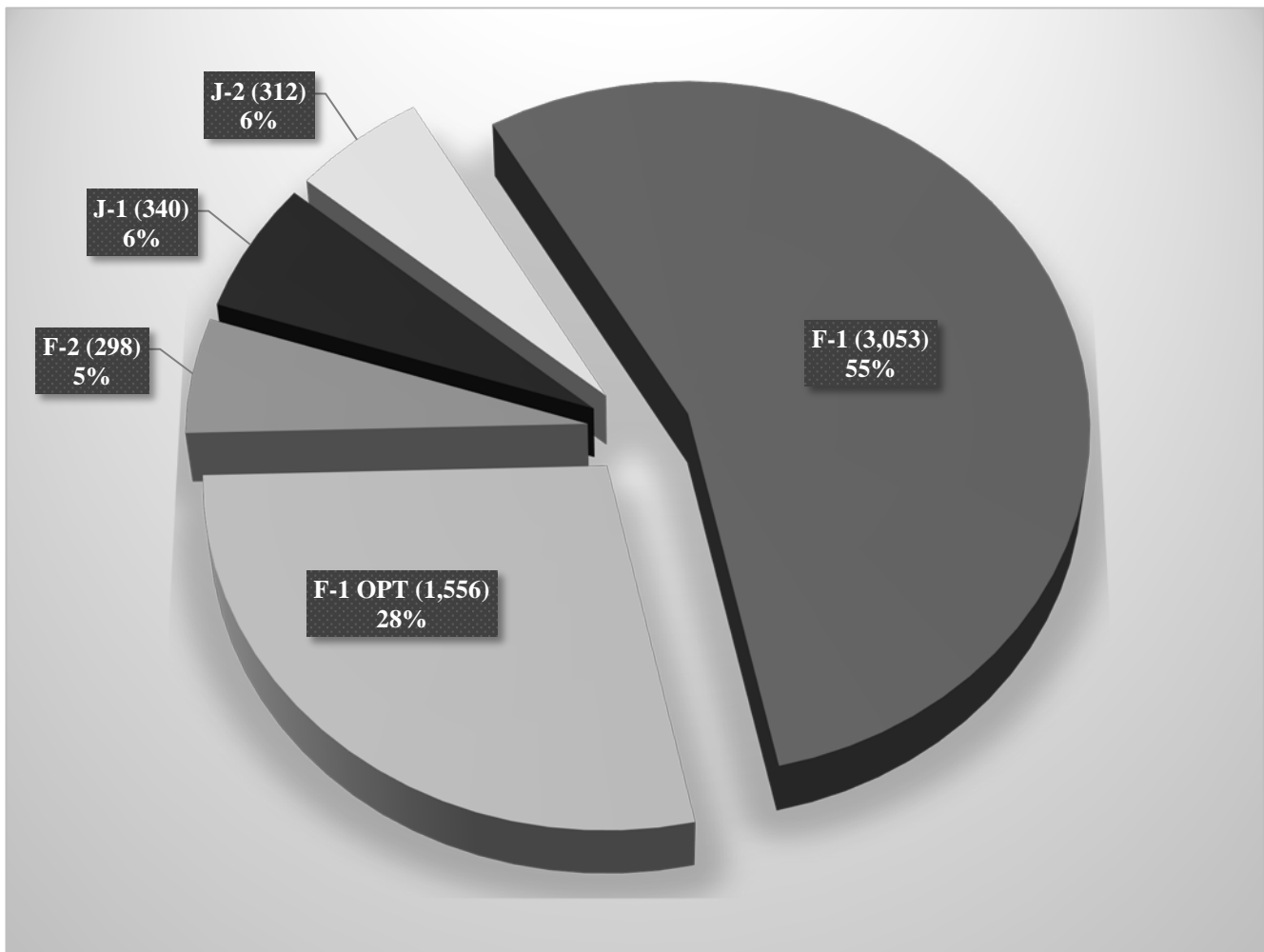

Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) Report

What is SEVIS?

The Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) is a U.S. government internet-based system that tracks current information on non-immigrant students (F and M visas), exchange visitors (J visa), and their dependents (F-2, M-2, and J-2). SEVIS allows schools and program sponsors to transmit electronic information and event notifications via the internet to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and U.S. Department of State (DOS) throughout the student's/exchange visitor's stay in the United States. SEVIS reflects changes in international student or exchange visitor status, admission at the Port of Entry (POE), changes of address, changes in program of study, employment authorizations, and other events. Immigration forms I-20 (F visas) and DS-2019 (J visas) are also issued through SEVIS.

The International Student and Scholar Services Office (ISSSO) was responsible for maintaining records in SEVIS for students, scholars, faculty, and dependents for the Fall 2019 semester that totals 5,559.

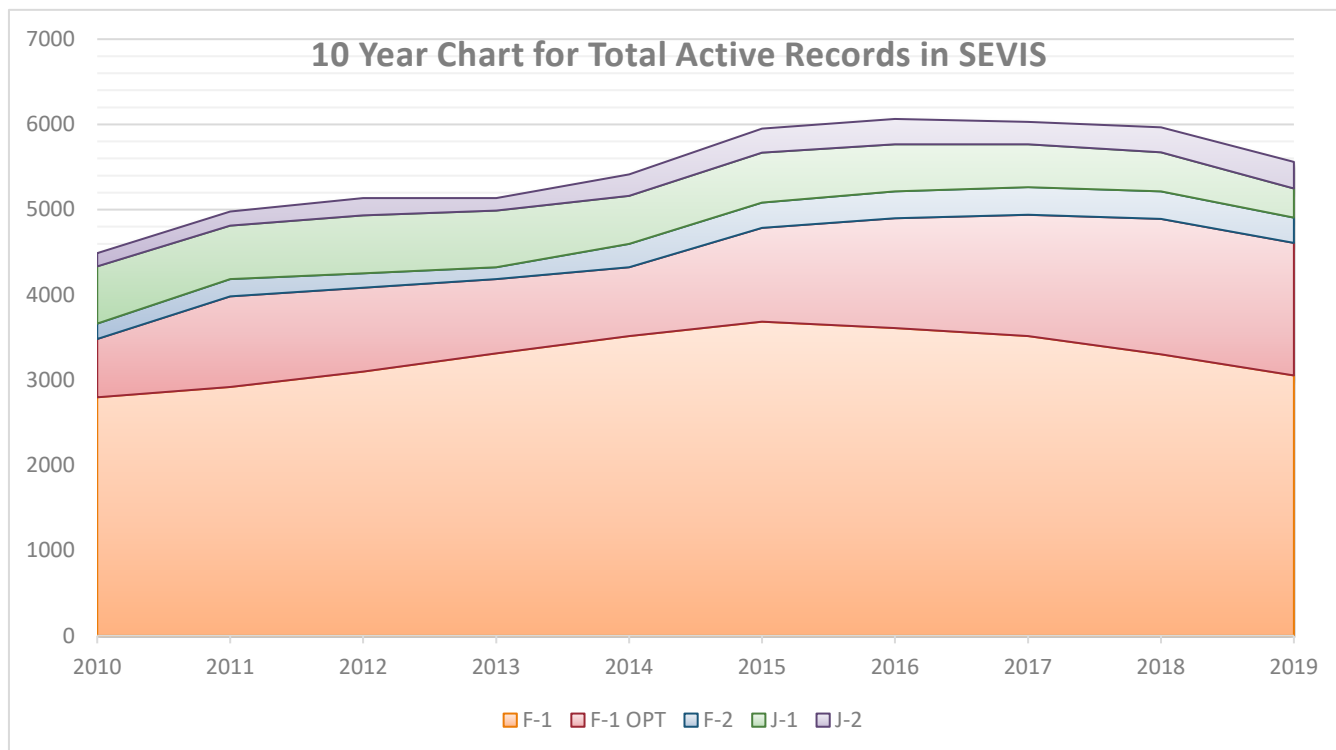

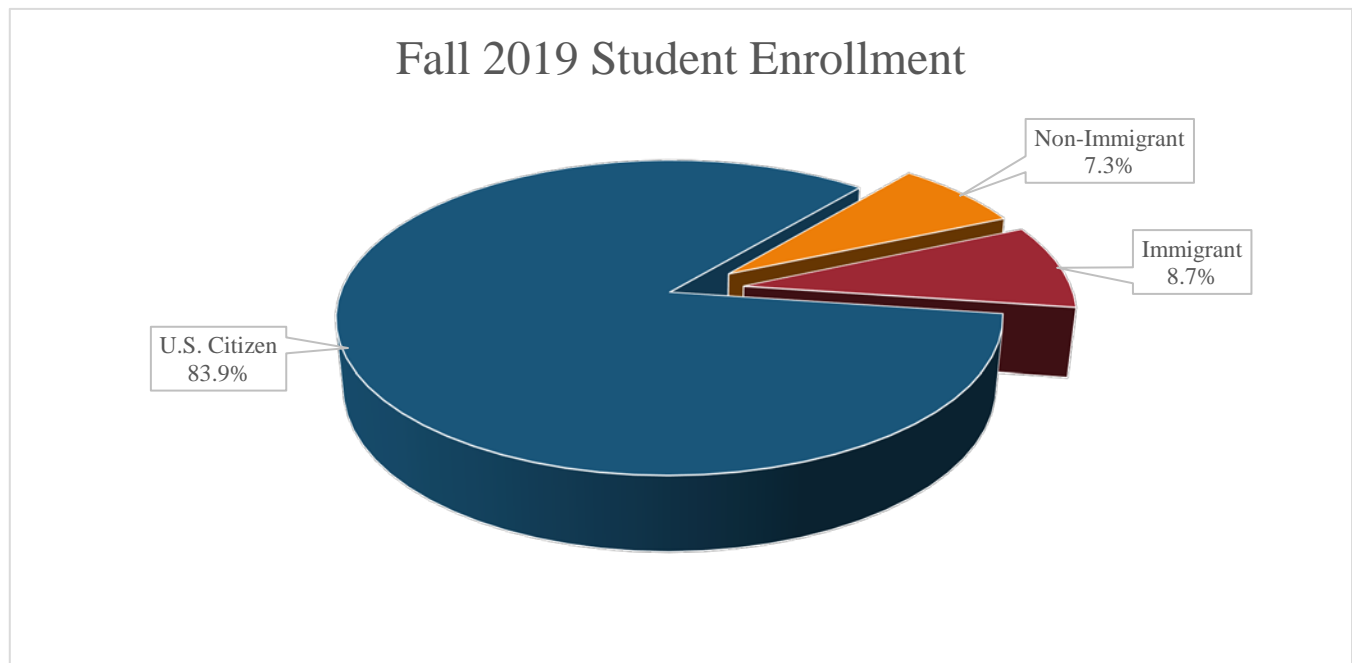

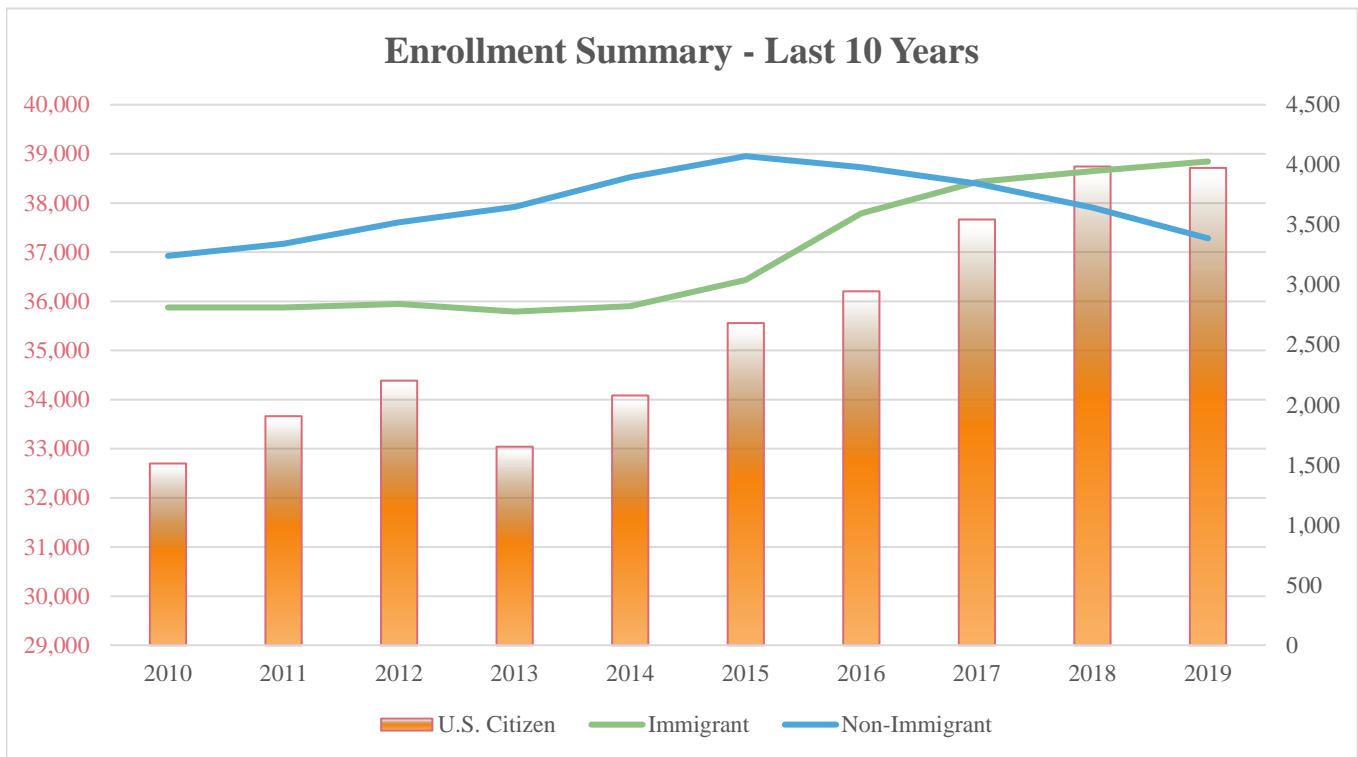

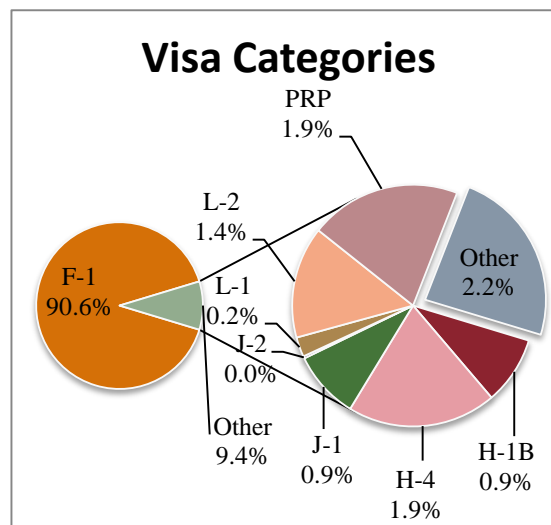

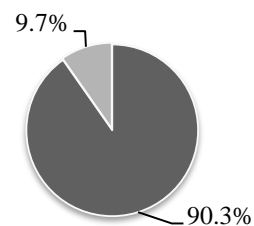

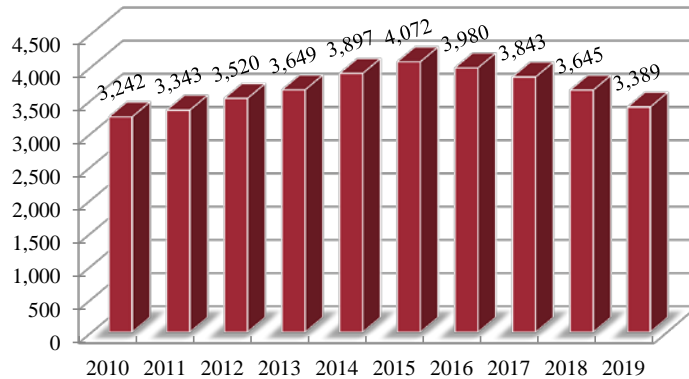

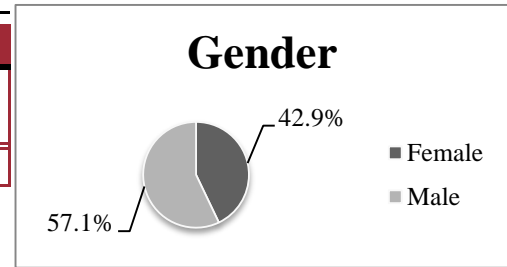

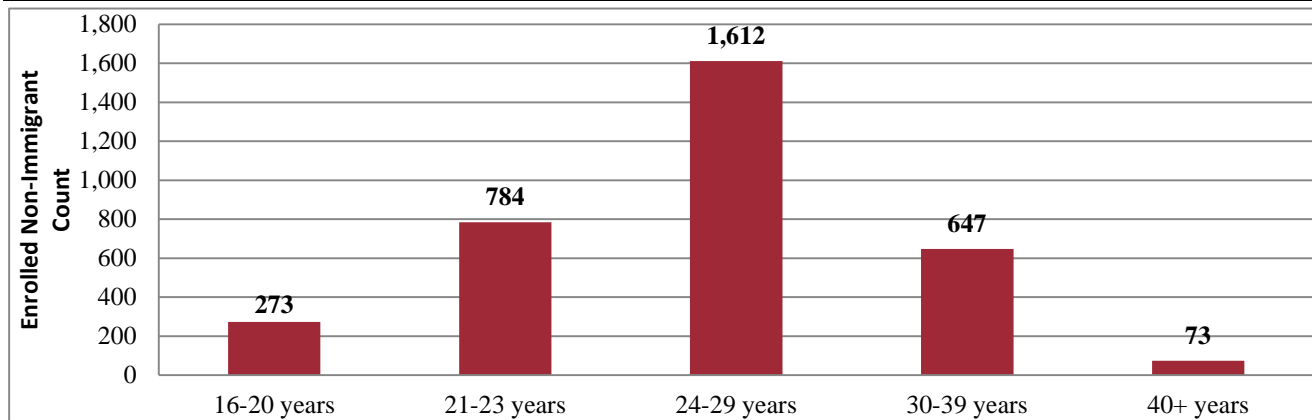
Non-Immigrant Enrollment Compositions: Fall 2019*

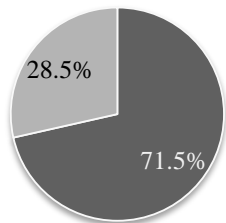


By Age



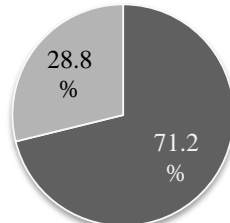
By New/Continuing Enrollment

Total Enrollment



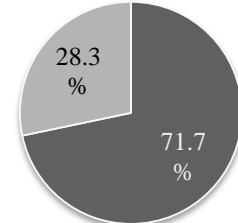

Graduate Enrollment

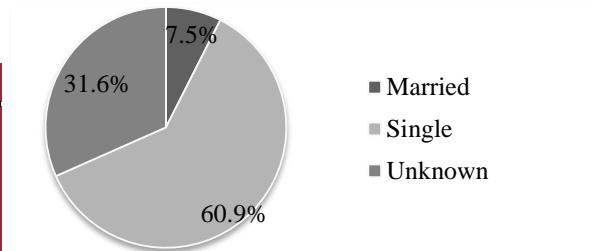

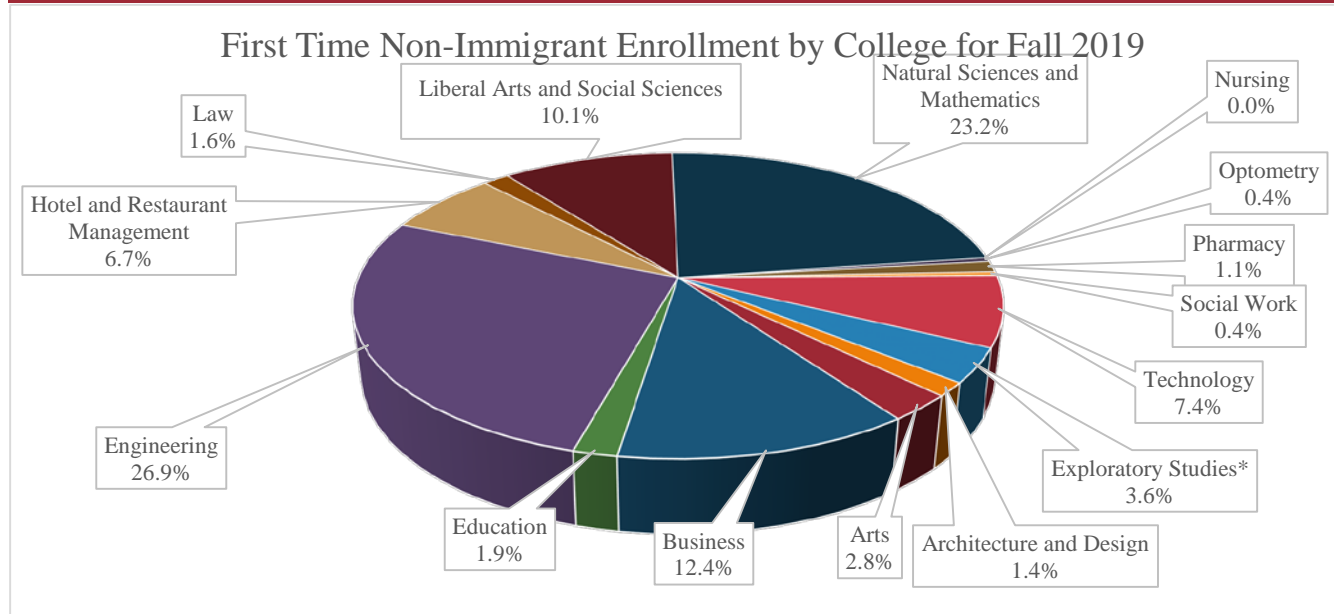

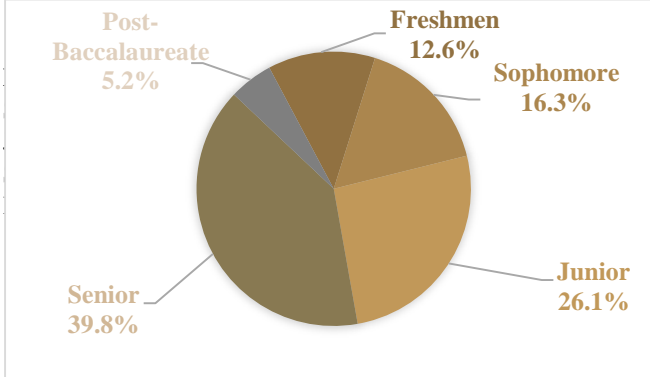

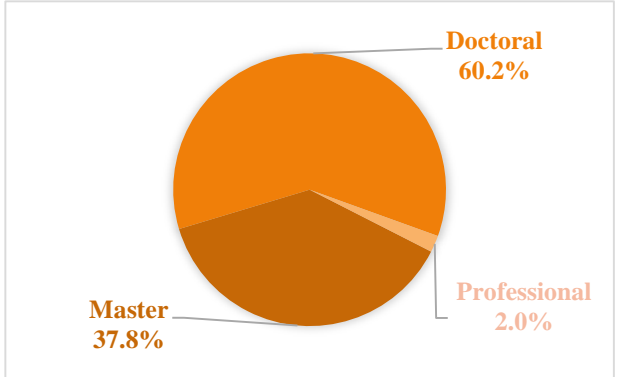

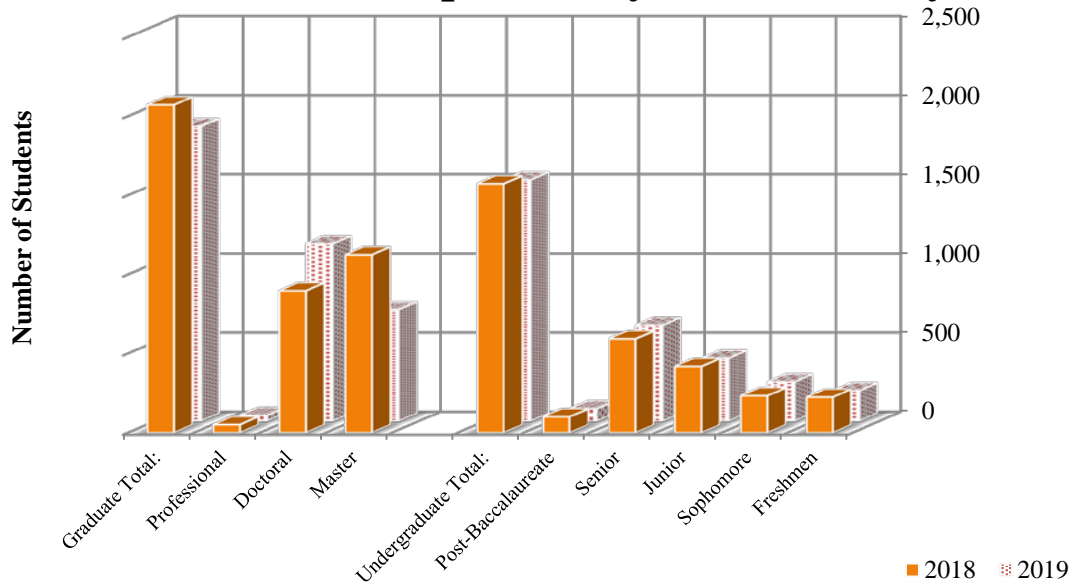
Undergraduate Composition



Graduate Composition



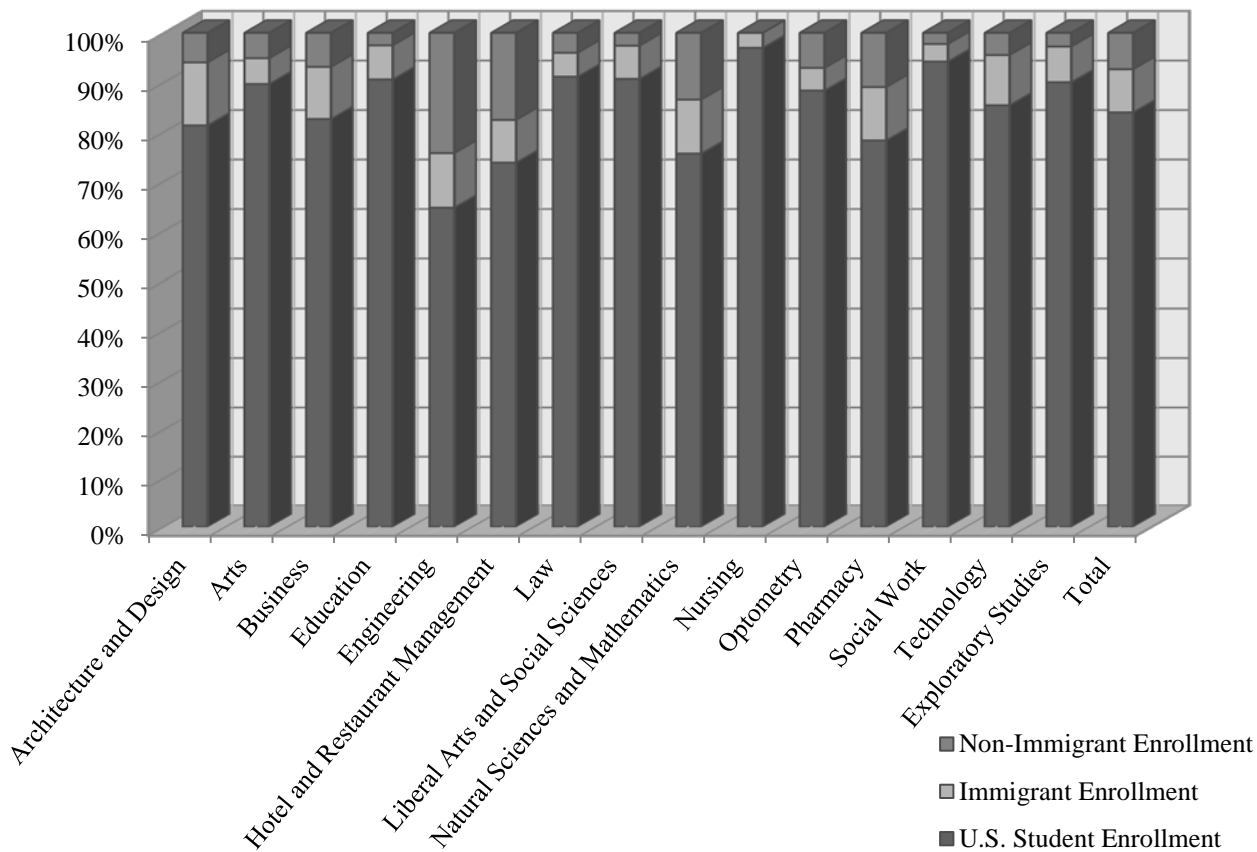
Fall 2018/2019 Comparison by Level of Study

Open Doors Report Explanation

The next few pages contain information specific to International Student and Scholar Services Office's reporting data to the Institute of International Education (IIE). It depicts non-immigrant enrollment counts by country of origin and field of study for the Fall 2019 semester at the University of Houston. Field of study designations were determined based on the Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) Codes associated with the student's primary major. These codes are not specific to a certain College, and should not be compared in this way. The following graphs will identify the trends for the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. and what role UH has for these countries. The first page will have information regarding enrollment of the top 25 countries in the U.S. while the following two pages have information for CIP code designations. As you will note, the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. are not the same as the top countries that are enrolled at the University of Houston. Iran, Nigeria, Mexico, Pakistan, and Venezuela, for example, are higher ranked on the list for UH, but not in the U.S. On the opposite end, Brazil, Germany, Japan, and Kuwait are in the top twenty-five sending countries in the U.S., but have much fewer numbers at UH. The overall increase of international students to the U.S. was .05% with Bangladesh and Brazil increasing around 10% while Saudi Arabia as whole dropped over 16%.

F-1 Employment Statistics: Optional Practical Training (OPT)

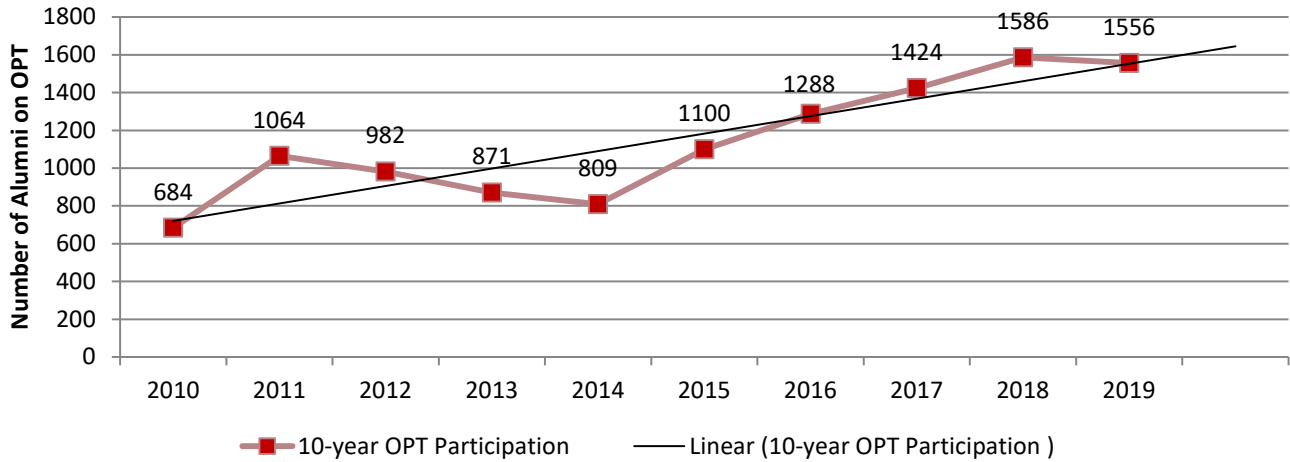
Non-immigrant students on the F-1 visa have the option of pursuing a 12-month employment benefit, immediately following completion of their degree program. The student must apply with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for permission to work. The student is able to accept employment that is directly related to her/his major area of study for a specified time period, upon approval. This time period is referred to as Optional Practical Training (OPT). Students graduating from certain science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) disciplines designated by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security may be eligible for an additional 24-month extension for a combined 36 months of OPT. There are 1,556 F-1 alumni from 78 nations participated in Optional Practical Training during Fall 2019.

J-1 Program Participation over the Past 10 Years



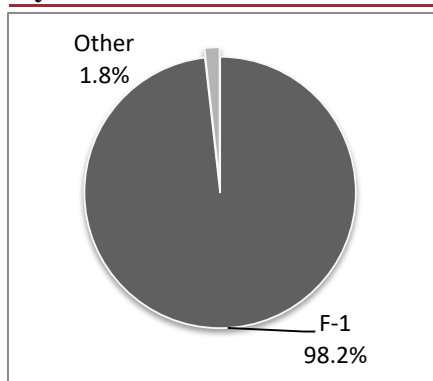
Language and Culture Center Enrollment: Fall 2019

The Language and Culture Center (LCC) is located on the University of Houston campus and provides students the ability to experience life at an American university while learning English as a Second Language (ESL) through a variety of courses designed to integrate them into the American educational system. LCC has provided intensive English instruction for international students on the University of Houston campus since 1975. LCC students may apply for admission to UH upon successful completion of the sixth and final level and passing TOEFL scores. Students enrolled in LCC programs are not enrolled in degree-seeking courses at UH and are therefore not included in the international student enrollment figures indicated earlier in this report. During the fall term of 2019, international students from 21 nations participated in the LCC program.

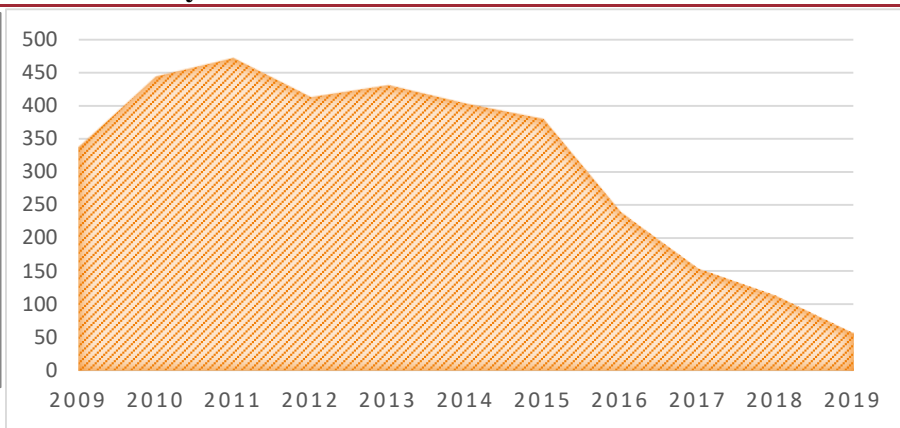
