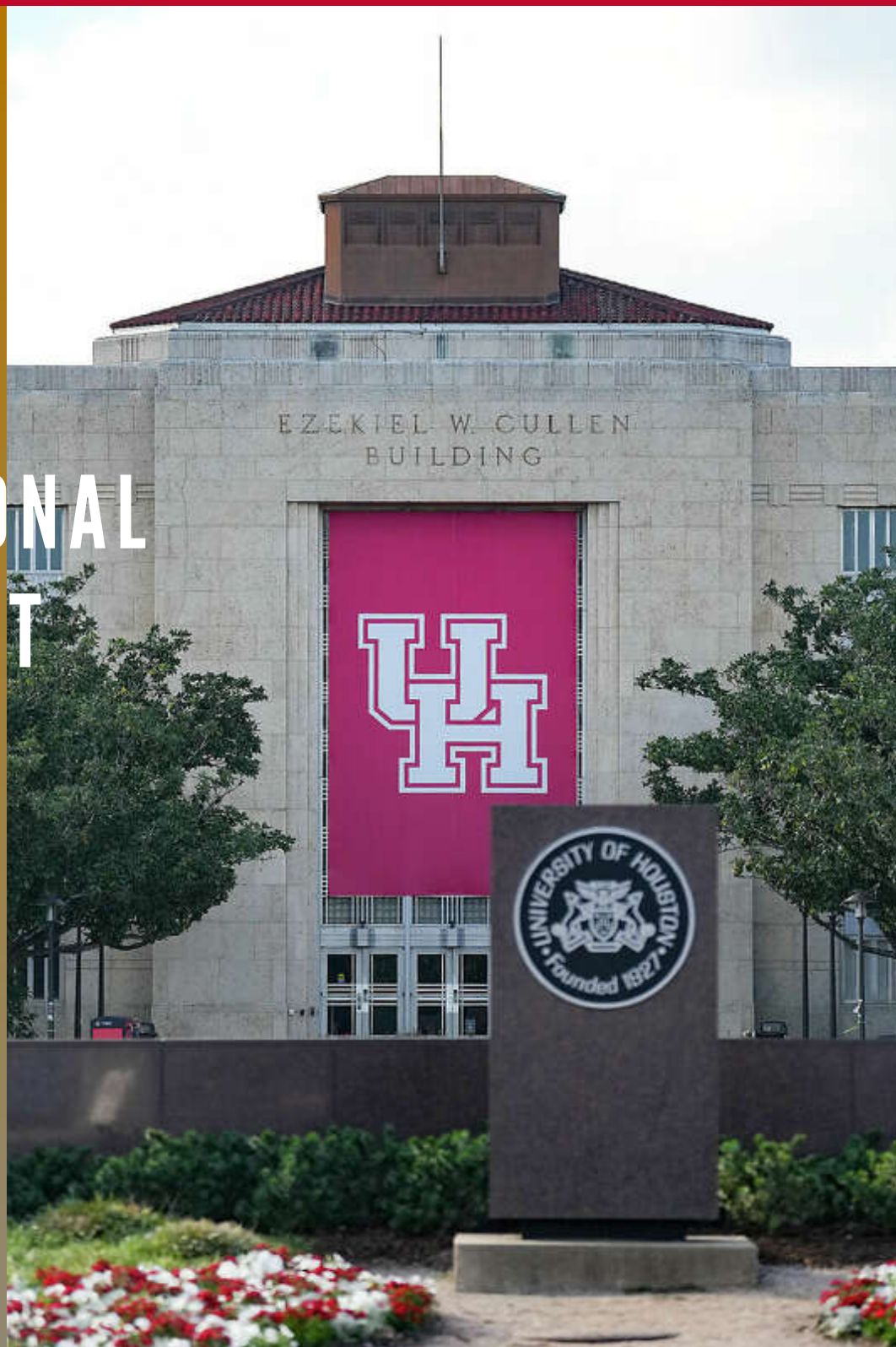

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The University of Houston is the doctoral degree-granting and largest university of the University of Houston System, a public system of higher education that includes three other universities (UH-Clear Lake, UH-Downtown, and UH-Victoria).

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Executive Summary

The Fall 2022 International Student Enrollment Report shows an even stronger growth of enrolled international students to the University of Houston (UH) by almost 15%. The population of non-immigrant students at UH has recovered to its 2017 enrollment numbers and is looking to quickly surpass the highest total non-immigration population in 2015 by next year. For our reporting system in SEVIS, the overall records maintained has increased 11.2% while the overall international F-1 student enrollment has increased by 15.1%. SEVIS records were over 5,500 in 2019 and dropped to the lowest since 2011 in 2020 at 4,763 students. As of fall 2022, these numbers are back up to 5,374. SEVIS tracks F1 students and alumni, F-2 dependents, and J1 scholars and their J-2 dependents. Every category has significantly increased outside of a slight decrease of F-1 alumni on OPT and OPT STEM Extension. This number will pick up as current students are graduating and pursuing work in the U.S.

For the top sending countries of students to UH, the top ten has remained the same. Though, within the list, the significant impact of an increase in international students at UH is due to India. The international student population from India increased 67.4%, going from 826 to 1,383 students alone. Vietnam has overtaken China as the number 2 sending country, even though both countries had a decrease of students. Nigeria, Mexico, Pakistan, and Iran continue to be strong sending countries whose population are increasing at UH. South Korea and Venezuela has seen a decrease of over 15%, but the biggest decrease is China with over 22% less students studying at UH.

The newly admitted students for fall 2022 saw a rise of over 15% for both graduate and undergraduate students. The newly admitted graduate numbers continue to break records having increased admissions from 748 to 866 in the prior year. Undergraduates saw their highest admitted number since 2018. The College of Technology saw the highest overall change of 83.1% compared to the prior year, going from 83 admitted students to 152. Most other colleges saw significant increases or similar enrollment numbers outside of the College of Global Hospitality Leadership which saw a decrease of 17.6%.

The F-1 alumni population on OPT has seen only a slight decrease since the prior year, going from 1,233 to 1,181. This is a continued decrease from the prior year. The alumni on OPT lags behind enrollment as students can be on OPT or OPT STEM Extension from one to three years depending on their major. The population of students on OPT STEM Extension is usually three times higher than that of students on post-completion OPT due to the length of time. In 2021, the population for OPT and OPT STEM have the same number (around 610 each) which means that the population will continue to decrease for the next few years before the new students begin to graduate and start their period of OPT. For 2022, these numbers have now gone back to normal which means that it's ready for rebound in 2023.

The J-1 population has grown significantly as well, as UH is beginning to invite more researchers and J-1 students to the campus. The overall population growth is 19% which can be attributed evenly to all categories of J-1. Last year, this report assumed that the J-1 population had hit its lowest point, which is proving true. We are seeing much higher numbers and with the collaboration of the Higher Educational Commission in Pakistan, we are getting a high number of J-1 students.

The overall numbers for international students and scholars are looking much stronger than in previous years as the University continues to strive to broaden its horizon.

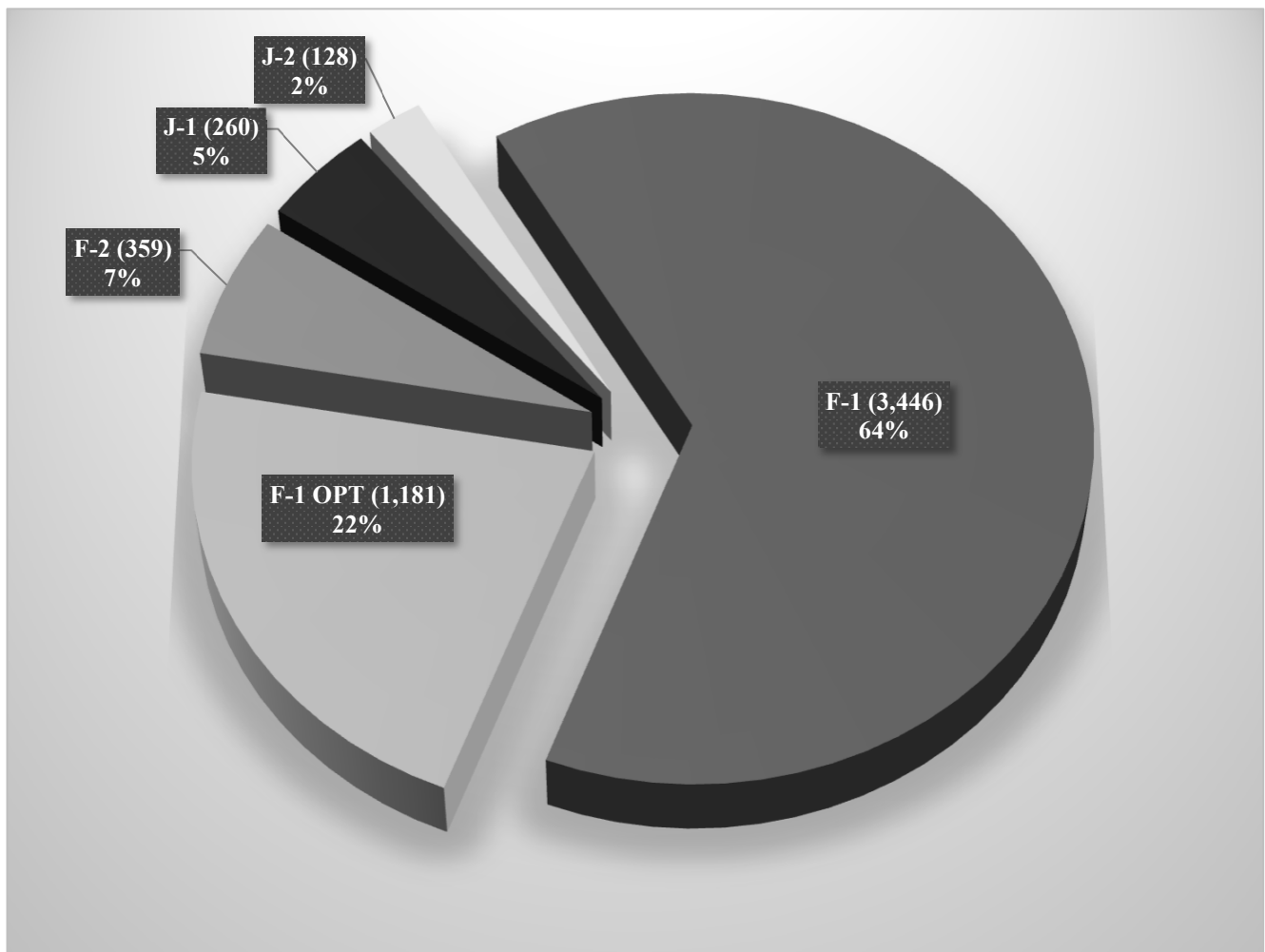

Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) Report

What is SEVIS?

The Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS) is a U.S. government internet-based system that tracks current information on non-immigrant students (F and M visas), exchange visitors (J visa), and their dependents (F-2, M-2, and J-2). SEVIS allows schools and program sponsors to transmit electronic information and event notifications via the internet to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and U.S. Department of State (DOS) throughout the student's/exchange visitor's stay in the United States. SEVIS reflects changes in international student or exchange visitor status, admission at the Port of Entry (POE), changes of address, changes in program of study, employment authorizations, and other events. Immigration forms I-20 (F visas) and DS-2019 (J visas) are also issued through SEVIS.

The International Student and Scholar Services Office (ISSSO) was responsible for maintaining records in SEVIS for students, scholars, faculty, and dependents for the Fall 2022 semester that totals 5,374.

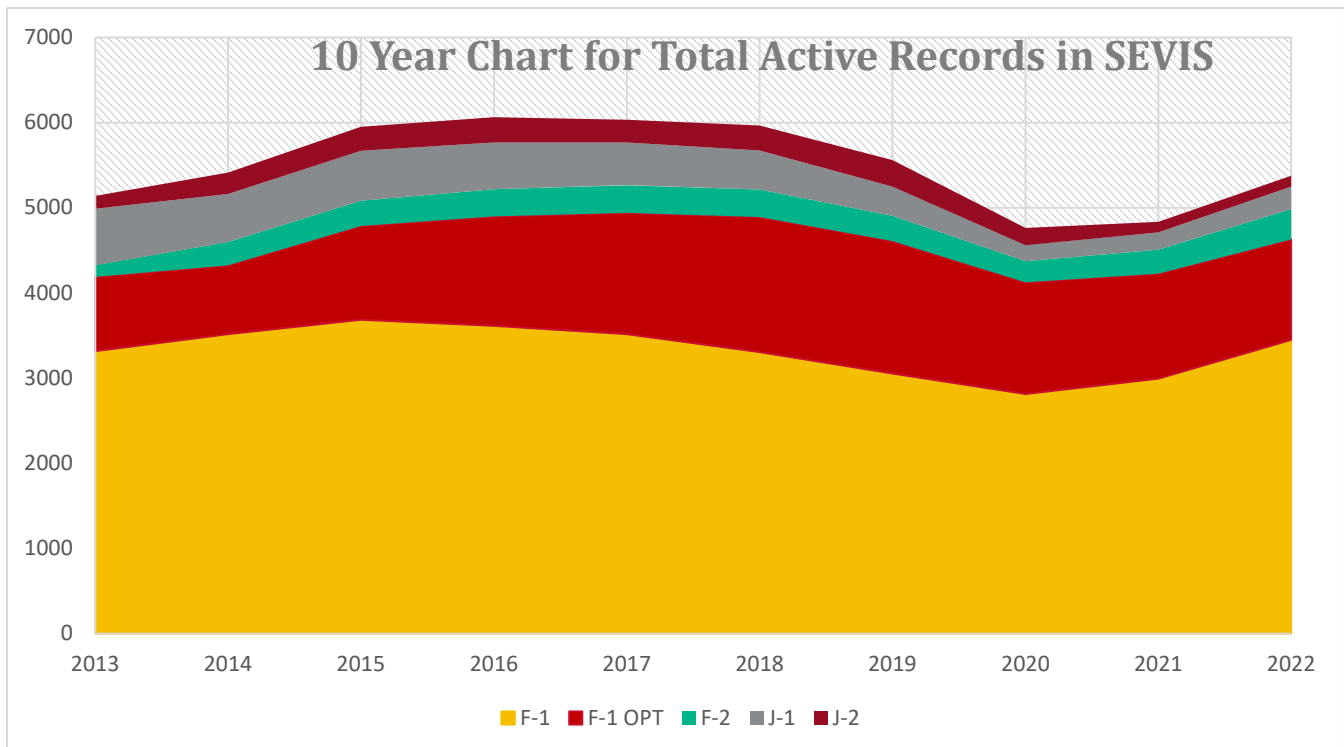

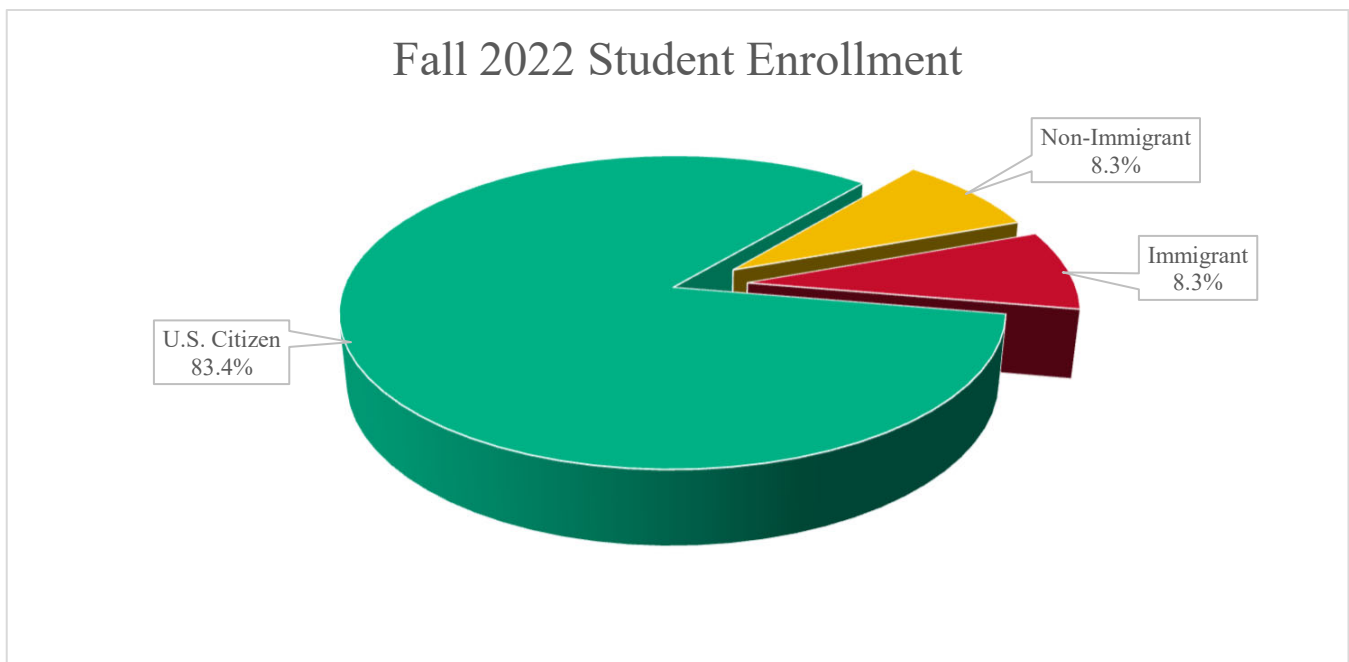

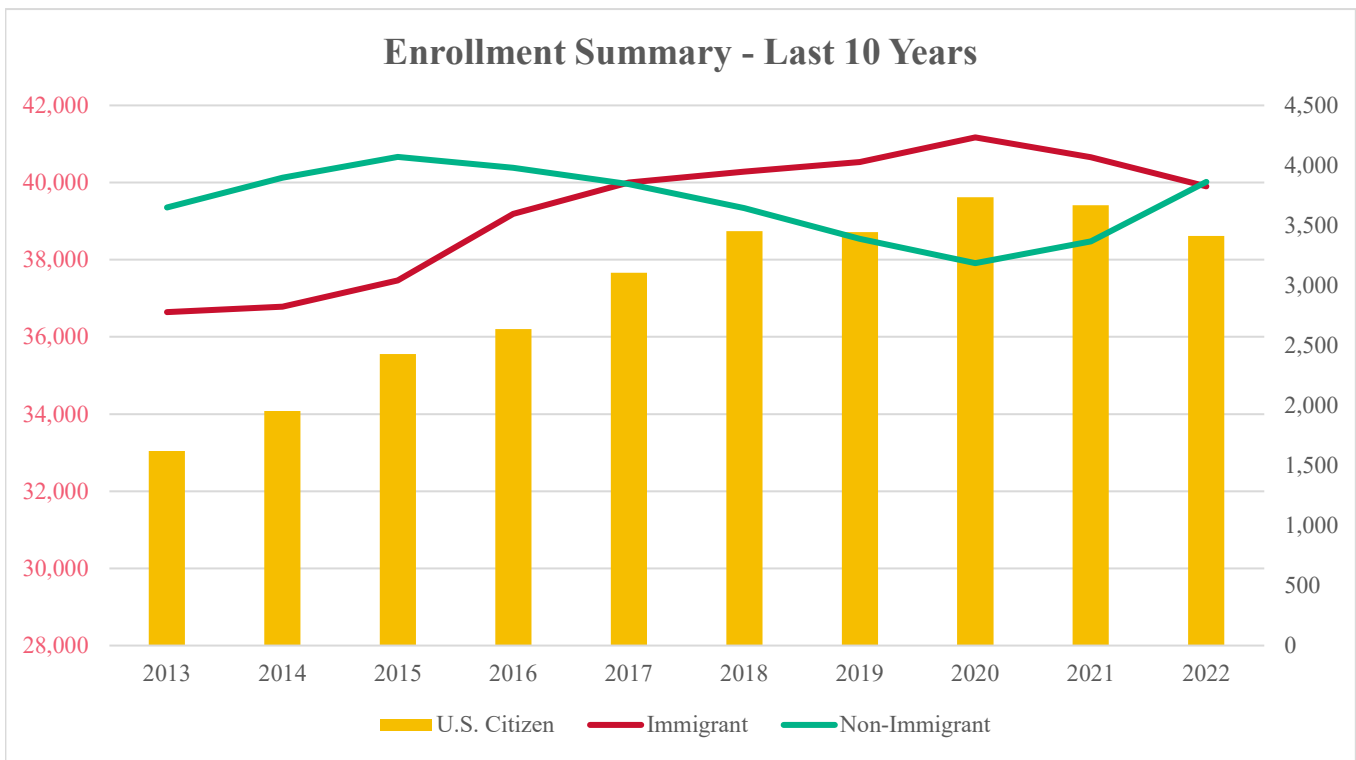

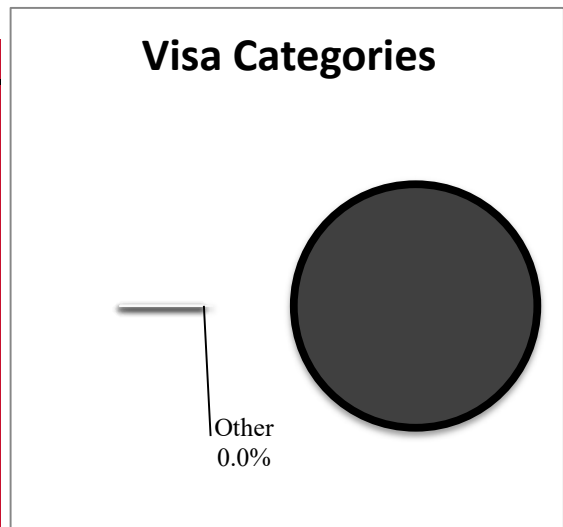

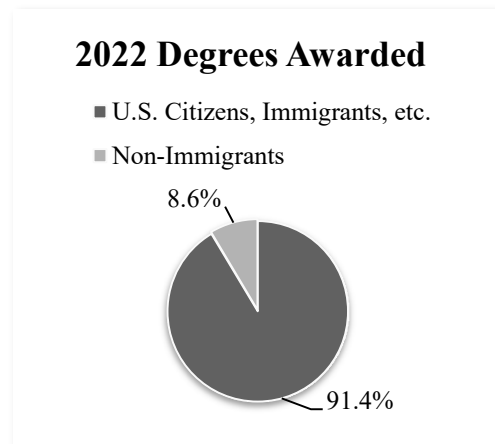

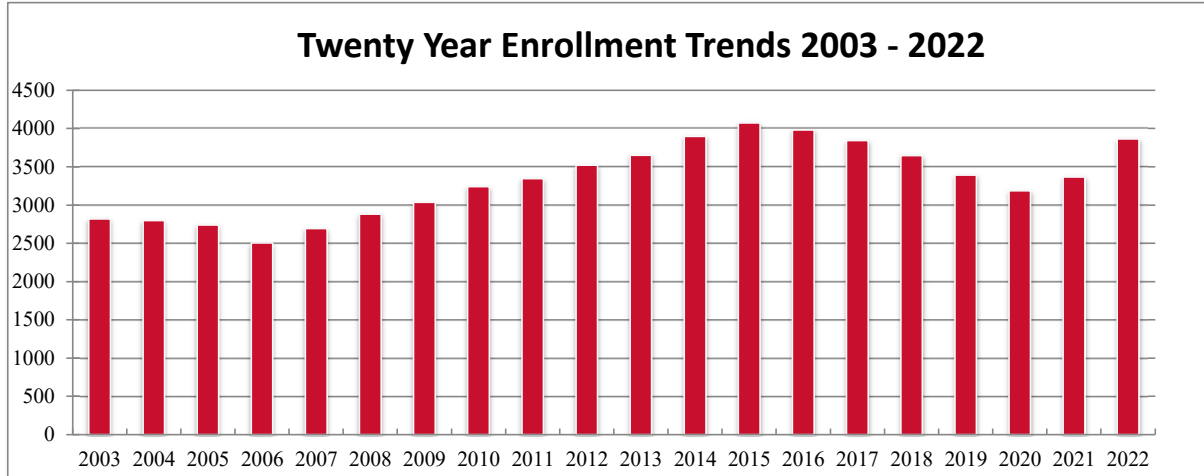

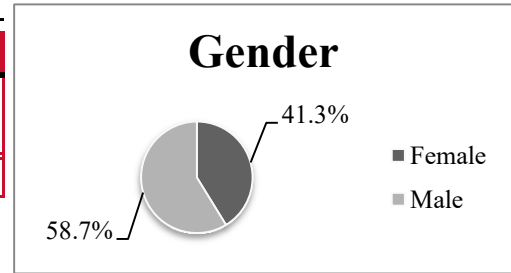

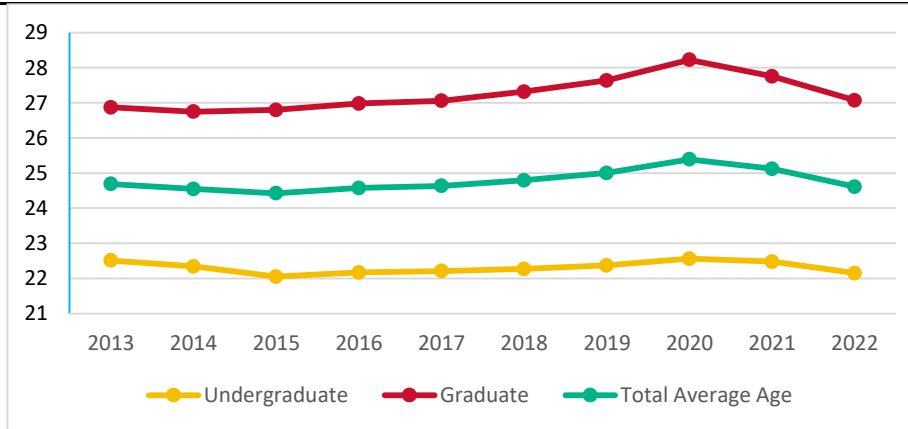
Non-Immigrant Enrollment Compositions: Fall 2022*

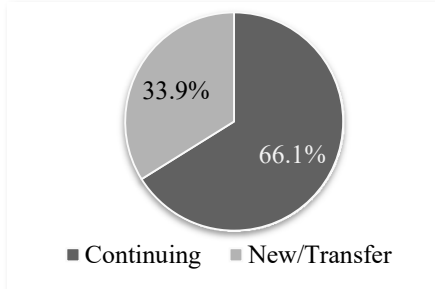


By Average Age Over Time

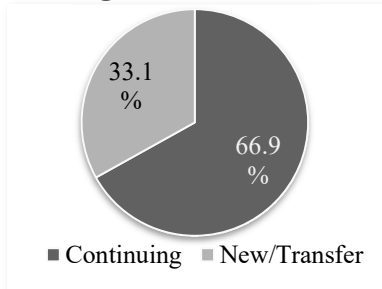


By New/Continuing Enrollment

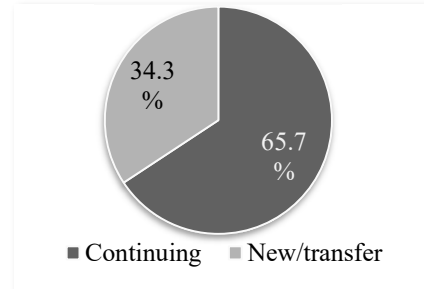
Total Enrollment



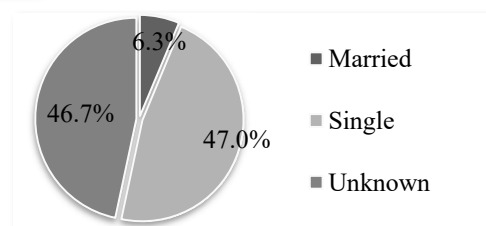
Undergraduate Enrollment

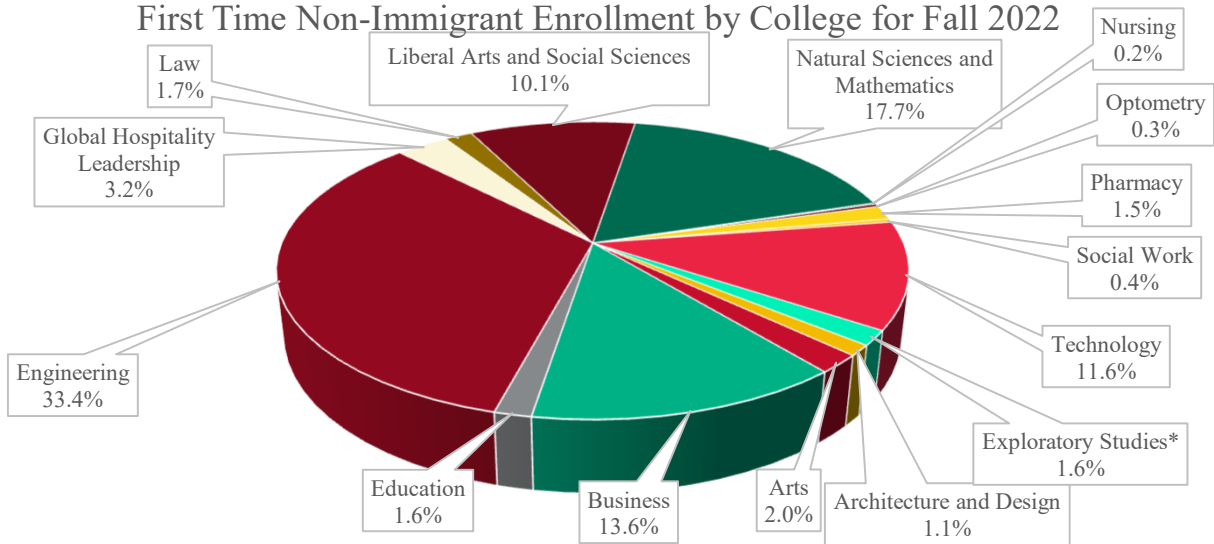

First Time Non-Immigrant Enrollment by College for Fall 2022



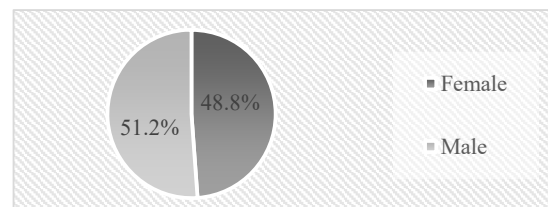

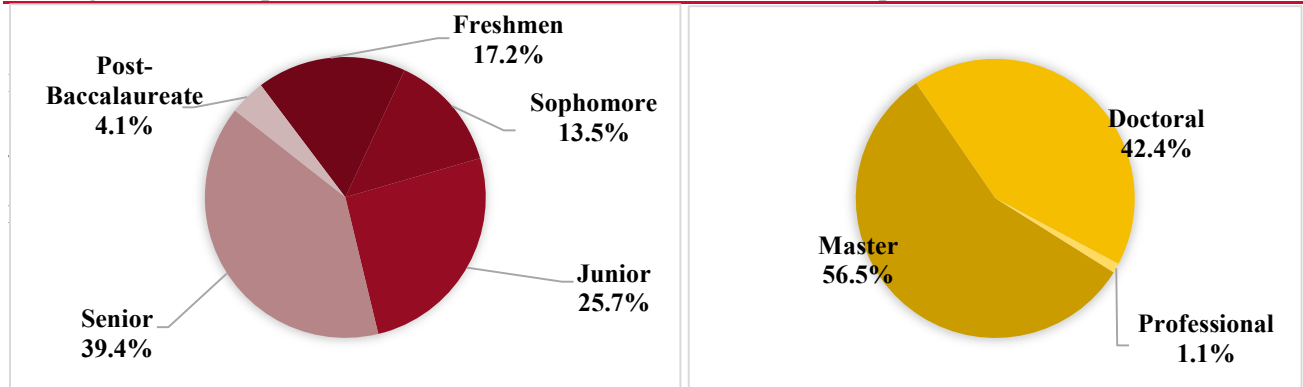

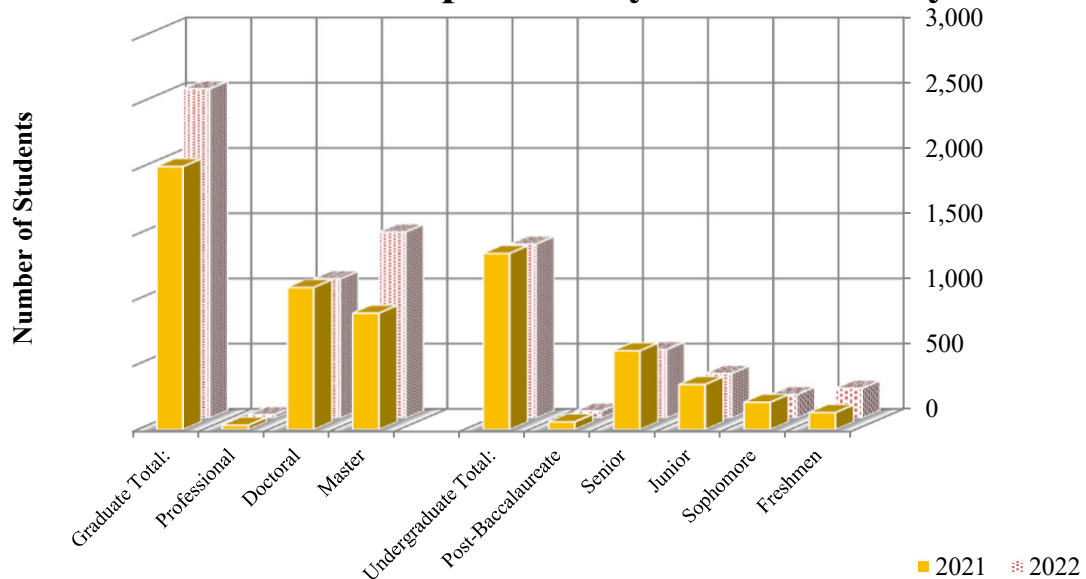

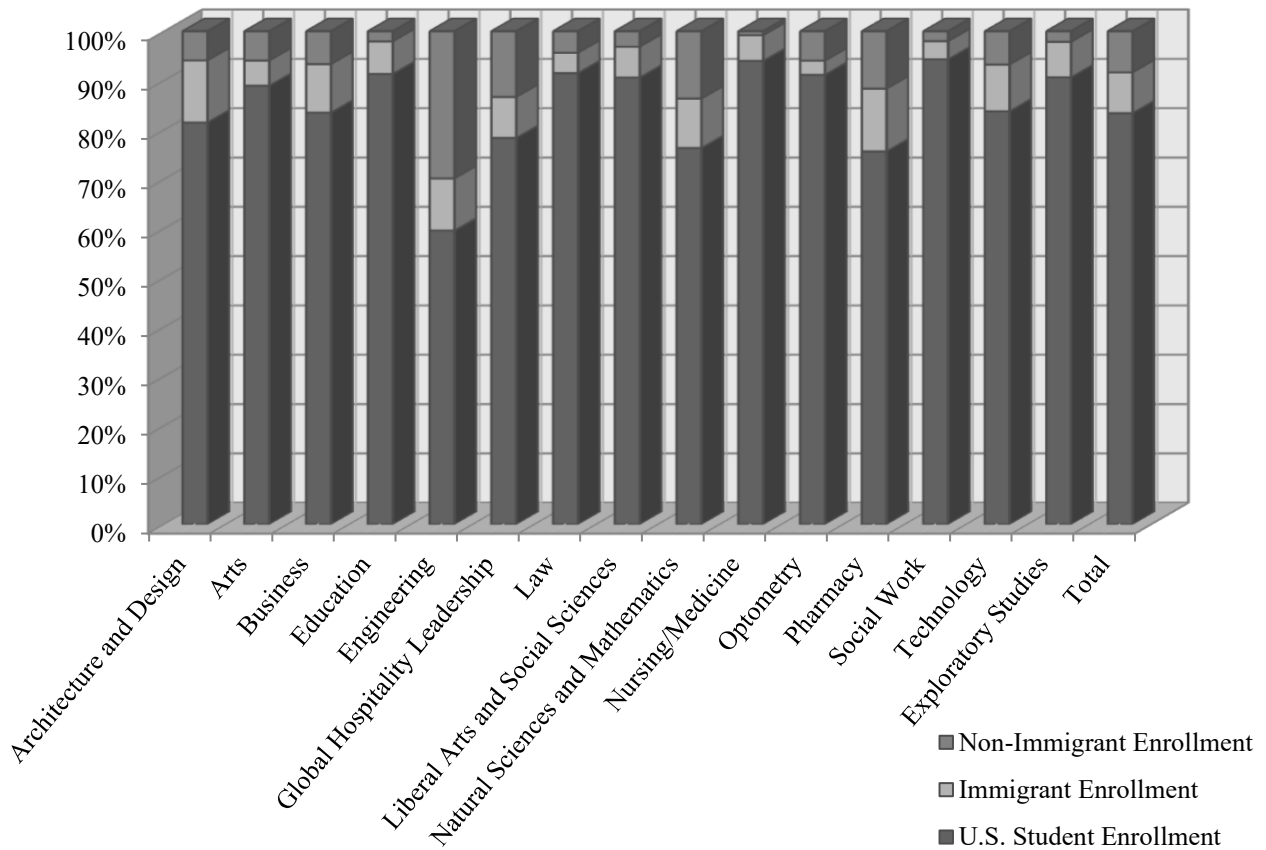
Fall 2021/2022 Comparison by Level of Study

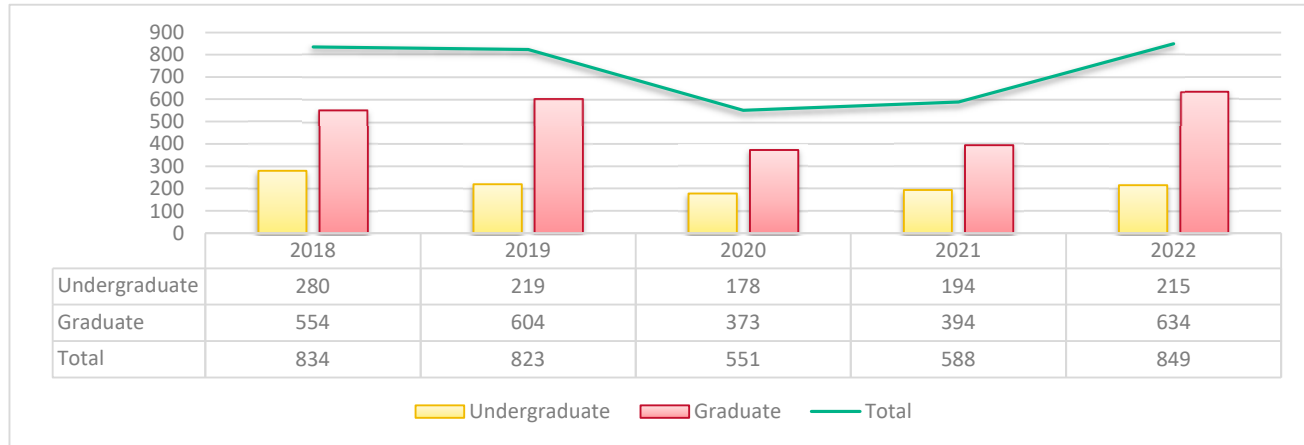
25 Year Non-Immigrant Enrollment Trends by Region



Fall 2022 Curricular Practical Training (CPT) Report

Curricular Practical Training (CPT) is an opportunity for non-immigrant students to gain practical work experience that is an integral part of their degree program. In order to be eligible for CPT, a department would either have to opt in for the experience track subplan and enroll in the University's COOP program, take a course that is part of the degree program and requires an internship or practicum experience to receive a grade, or be an essential part of a student's dissertation. CPT's are authorized per semester and a new application has to be approved for any subsequent semester that a student wishes to continue doing their practical training.

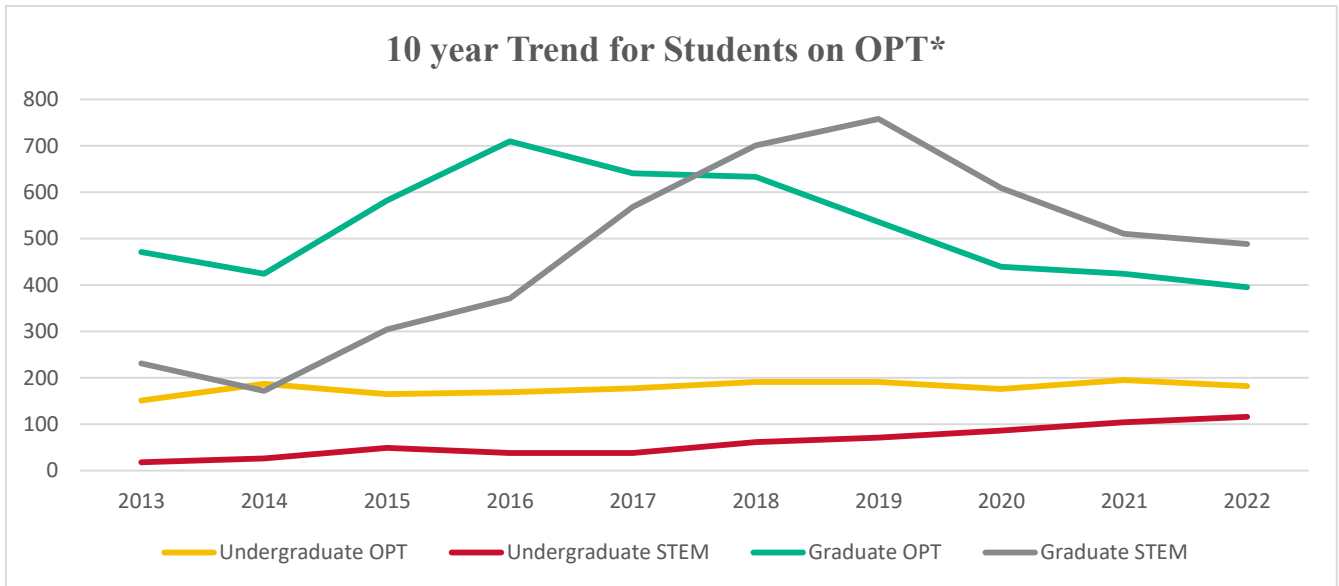
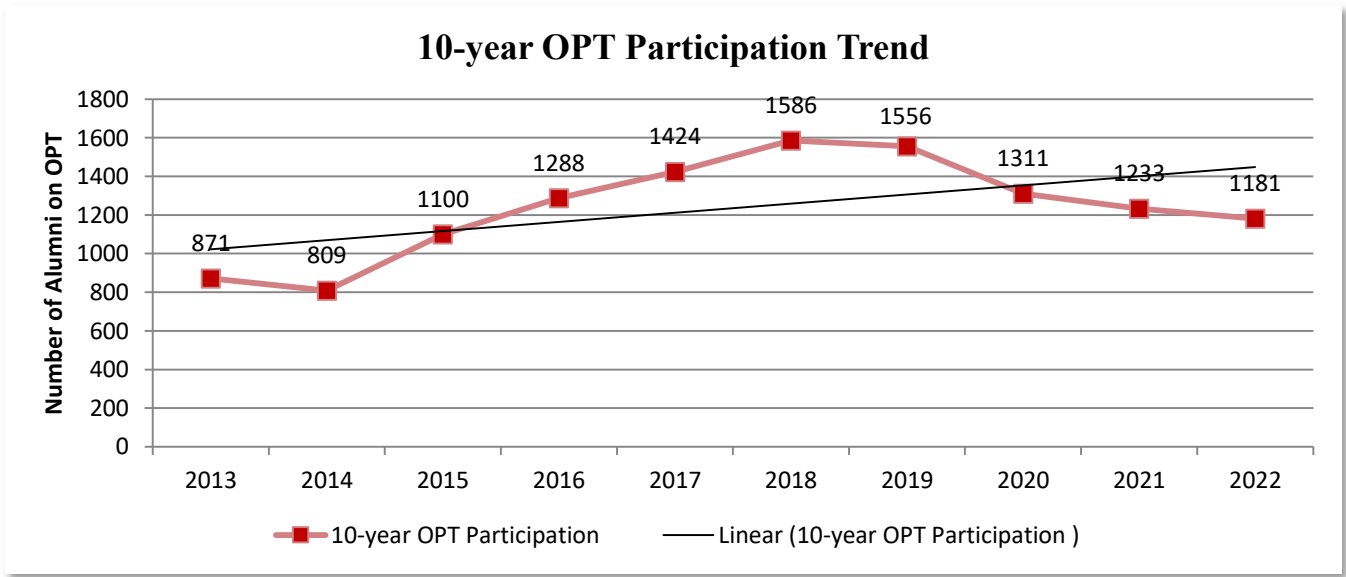
F-1 Employment Statistics: Optional Practical Training (OPT)

Non-immigrant students on the F-1 visa have the option of pursuing a 12-month employment benefit, immediately following completion of their degree program. The student must apply with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) for permission to work. The student is able to accept employment that is directly related to her/his major area of study for a specified time period, upon approval. This time period is referred to as Optional Practical Training (OPT). Students graduating from certain science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) disciplines designated by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security may be eligible for an additional 24-month extension for a combined 36 months of OPT. There are 1,181 F-1 alumni from 79 nations that participated in Optional Practical Training during Fall 2022.

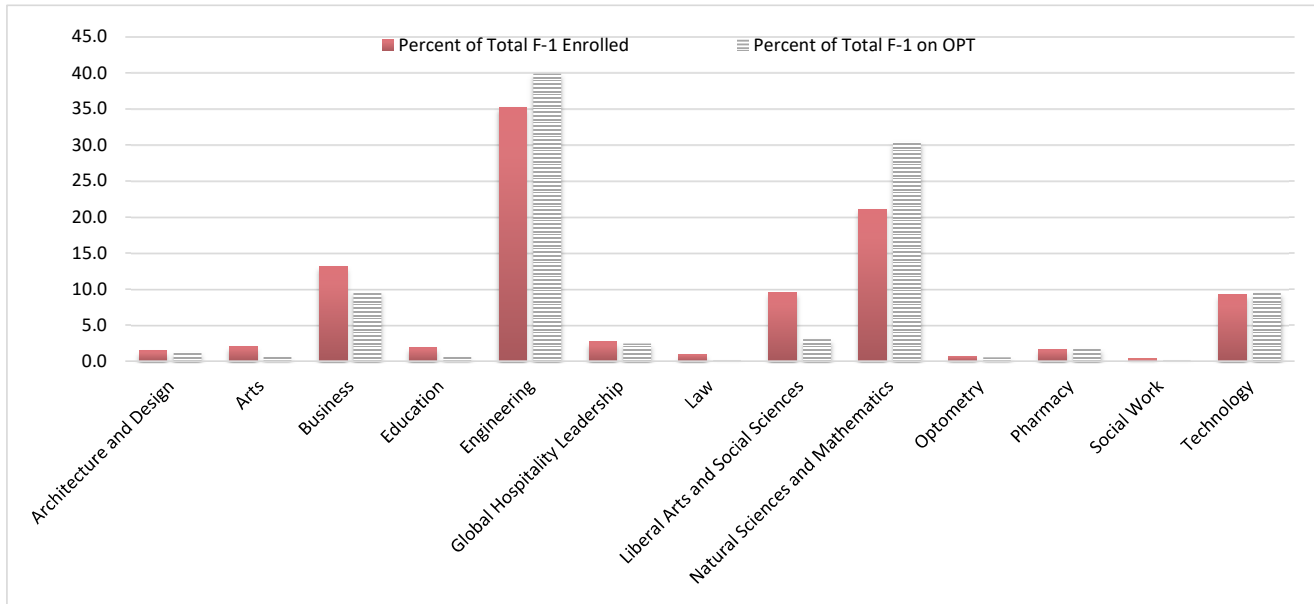

Top 25 Countries of Origin Report

Open Doors Report Explanation

The next few pages contain information specific to International Student and Scholar Services Office's yearly reporting data to the Institute of International Education's (IIE) Open Door report. It depicts non-immigrant enrollment counts by country of origin and field of study for the Fall 2021 semester at the University of Houston. Field of study designations were determined based on the Classification of Instructional Program (CIP) Codes associated with the student's primary major. These codes are not specific to a certain college, and should not be compared in the same way. The following tables identify the trends for the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. for school year 2021/2022 and what role of incoming students UH has had for these sending countries and the current enrollment data that will be sent for fall 2022.

The first page contains information regarding enrollment rank of the top 25 countries in the U.S. and how many of these students study at UH while the following two pages have information regarding the CIP code designations. As you will note, the top 25 sending countries to the U.S. are not the same as the top countries that are enrolled at the University of Houston. Iran, Nigeria, Mexico, Pakistan, and Colombia, for example, are higher ranked on the list for UH, but not in the entire U.S. On the opposite end, Brazil, Germany, Japan, Indonesia, UK, and Kuwait are in the top twenty-five sending countries to the U.S., but have much fewer numbers at UH. The overall enrollment change of international students to the U.S. in 2021/2022 increased by 3.8% while the numbers at UH have increased significantly by 14.7% showing that UH is rebounding much better than the rest of the U.S. post-COVID19. This is a significant difference, and it shows that UH has a strong foundation for learning and recruiting international students for both undergraduate and graduate studies.

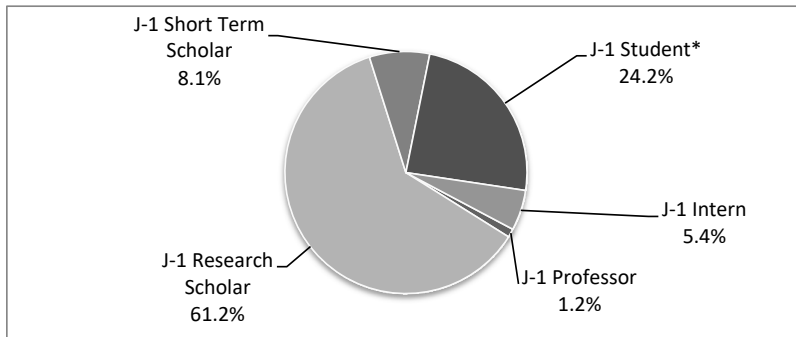

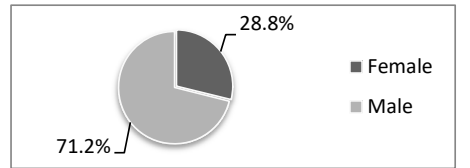

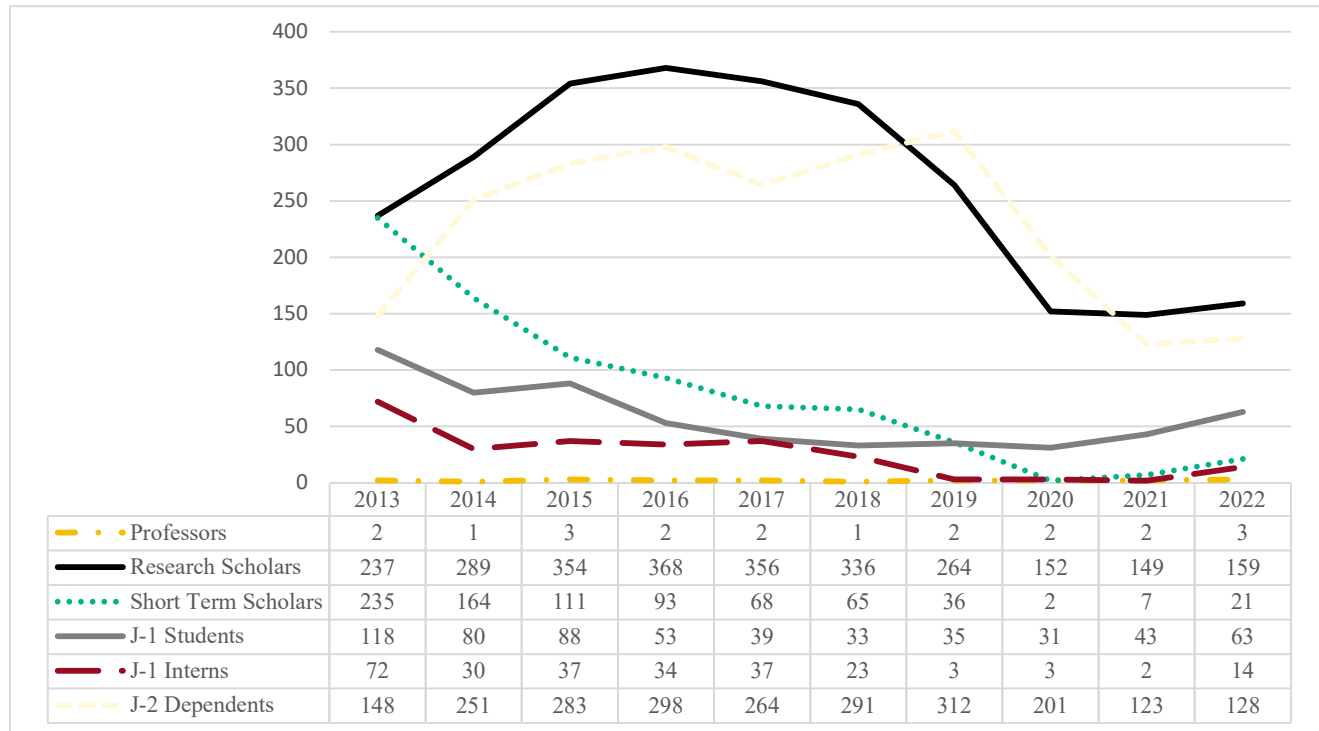

J-1 Program Participation over the Past 10 Years



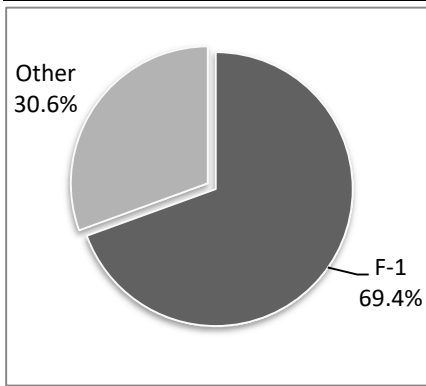
Language and Culture Center Enrollment: Fall 2022

The Language and Culture Center (LCC) is located on the University of Houston campus and provides students the ability to experience life at an American university while learning English as a Second Language (ESL) through a variety of courses designed to integrate them into the American educational system. LCC has provided intensive English instruction for international students on the University of Houston campus since 1975. LCC students may apply for admission to UH upon successful completion of the sixth and final level and passing TOEFL scores. Students enrolled in LCC programs are not enrolled in degree-seeking courses at UH and are therefore not included in the international student enrollment figures indicated earlier in this report. During the fall term of 2022, international students from 20 nations participated in the LCC program.

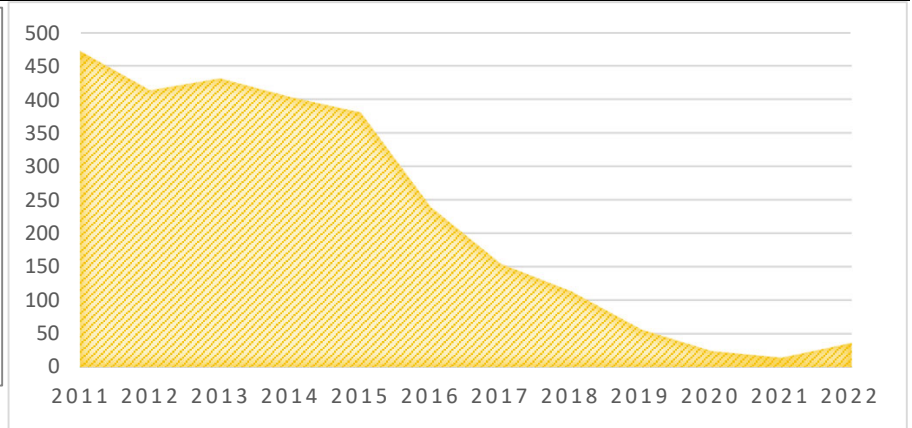
