Qualifications	<p>Qualified applicants must have the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Active licensure in counseling (LPC), marriage and family therapy (LMFT), social work (LCSW), or other appropriate licensure issued by the state board. ● A master's or doctoral degree in counseling, psychology, marriage and family therapy, or social work. ● Individual malpractice Insurance. ● Experience creating treatment plans, progress notes, safety/crisis planning, and other relevant documentation. ● Submitting documentation to EHR within 72 hours of session. ● Experience working with LGBTQIA+ individuals and understanding of issues specific to the community (e.g., gender dysphoria, coming out, discrimination, family dynamics). ● Competence in trauma-informed care and culturally sensitive practices. ● Interest in being trained in trauma-specific modalities such as EMDR, ART, Brainspotting, etc.
